DELIGHTFUL VILLAGE HOUSE WITH A PLUNGE POOL, PATIO & TERRACE

Designed by a local architect, this charming and unusual village property was built to a high standard in 2008 and includes insulated cavity walls, hardwood double-glazed windows (with tilt feature) and gas central heating. The quirky split level design creates a spacious ambience with plenty of natural light throughout.

The house is located in a quiet street just below the Castle with on-street parking nearby. Just a few minutes walk away there is a variety of shops, tapas bars and high quality restaurants.

Ground floor (split level):

The entrance level comprises a spacious Andalusian-style kitchen with hardwood work surfaces and marble shelving below, double stainless steel sink and Bosch 5-ring gas hob. There is a dining table (for 6 people), plenty of storage space, boiler room, gas store.

The upper level has a unique feature arch allowing more natural light into the kitchen below. It comprises a cosy, comfortable sitting room with a wood-burning stove. There are floor-to-ceiling glazed sliding doors opening onto the patio area - a lovely shady spot for 'al-fresco' dining. From the patio there are steps leading up to the poolside terrace. There is also a well-presented bathroom with full size bath and overhead shower on this level.

First floor (split level):

The lower level initially contained 2 double bedrooms each with French door & 'Juliet' balcony. This area is now open-plan and used as a Yoga & Art studio, but it would be easy to restore the two bedrooms at low cost.

The upper level comprises the Master bedroom, with vaulted ceiling, built-in storage and a glazed French door opening onto a 'Juliet' balcony overlooking the pool area and with views of the Castle. Adjacent there is a separate bathroom with a mosaic tiled walk-in shower.

Second floor:

This floor comprises a utility and storage area with a glazed door leading to the spacious roof terrace.

Exterior:

The walled al-fresco dining patio is accessed from the sitting room. A few steps lead up to the attractive salt-water plunge pool, finished with mosaic tiling and a built-in seat. The adjacent poolside terrace is private and has plenty of room for sunbeds.

The south-facing roof terrace is very private - from here there are views across the village rooftops to El Hacho mountain in the west with spectacular sunsets.
